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First Recovery and Reinvestment Contracts Advertised for DOH March Bidding

CHARLESTON—Two bridge overlays, one slide repair and five resurfacing projects totaling 11 miles are among the first Reinvestment and Recovery contracts to be advertised for upcoming Division of Highways bid openings March 19, Gov. Joe Manchin announced today.

“We are putting the stimulus funds to work responsibly and as quickly as possible,” Manchin said. “These first highways projects should help to create jobs in West Virginia and, as with every project we fund through the Recovery Act, we are committed to spending taxpayer money wisely.”

To be bid in March, the Latex Modified Concrete Bridge Overlays include the eastbound and westbound sides of the Oakvale Bridge, along US 460 in Mercer County and in Monroe County at the Alderson Bridge along WV 3.

A Pendleton County contract calls for slide repairs with pilings along Franklin Road on US 220.

Resurfacing contracts to be bid March 19 call for the following:

MARION—2.19 miles Pricketts Fort Road in Fairmont along I-79, beginning from WV 310 to County 33

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MERCER—1.67 miles Bluefield Road along US 460

PLEASANTS—2.72 miles Willow Island Road in Waverly along WV 2
beginning .10 miles north of Wood County Line and ending .30 miles South of County 6

RITCHIE—2.18 miles Camp Run Road in Nutter Farm along US 50, beginning
.10 miles west of junction of County 5 to the junction of County 50/4

RITCHIE—2.23 miles Ellenboro Road in Camp Run along US 50, .035 miles
west of junction of County 5 to .02 miles west of Bonds Creek Bridge
